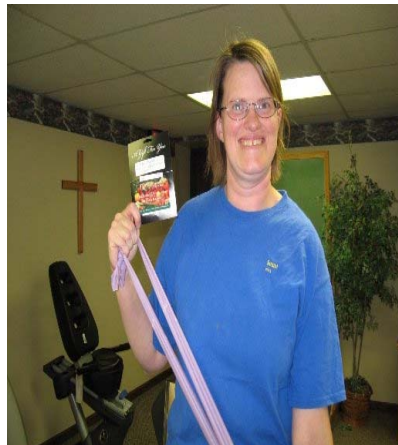
Wellness Blog

Bill of Rights of Pleasant View Home

21. The Resident has the right to immediate access to any of the following:
 - any representative of the Secretary of the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services.
 - any representative of the State
 - the Resident's individual physician
 - the States Long Term Care Ombudsman
 - the agency responsible for the protection of and advocacy system for mentally ill or developmentally disabled individuals.
22. The Facility must provide reasonable access to any Resident by an entity or individual that provides health, social, legal or other services to the Resident subject to the Resident's right to deny or withdraw consent.
23. The Resident has a right to have reasonable access to the private use of a telephone.

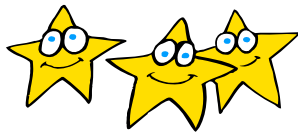

earth” and she really enjoyed meeting him. Amy, evening staff member, came in on her day off and touched up the paint job on Bertha’s walker for the trip to

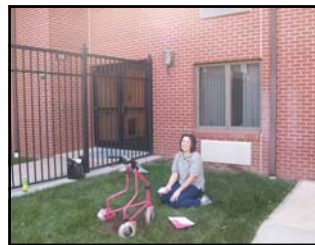
Topeka. Way to go Amy, you’re the BEST!!

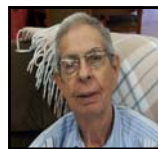
Sara graced us with her wonderful talent of playing the organ. We enjoyed her musical abilities very much!

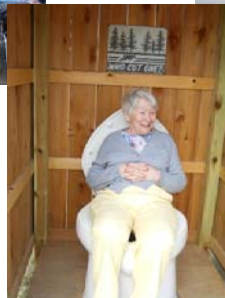

13 Ivy Grove residents went to the Kansas State Fair on the 12th of September. It was a nice warm day and everyone had a great time! A BIG


