## Chaplain's Article PVH News June, 2018 Issue Acts 27:20 NIV

When neither sun nor stars appeared for many days and the storm continued raging, we finally gave up all hope of being saved.

Dr. David Jeremiah shared the following story in his magazine "Turning Points" (June 2016, p. 33): "One morning...a well-known actor was riding through Atlanta following eighty hours of exhaustive filming on a movie. Looking over the darkened streets, he felt burdened for the downtrodden. The actor, who professes Christ, wrote a note on Instagram. He recalled the many years when he had to 'hustle hard and go hungry. I had to eat sardines and figure out how to get gas money,' he said. 'Don't give up.' He credits his inspiration to an encounter outside a liquor store when he was 19. A stranger stopped him, told him about Christ, and gave him a message changed his life."

Our world is filled with seeming hopeless situations; a family continues to look for a child, now missing for several months; families in Syria are in despair because they now survive in a tent, living at the mercy of caring agencies; mothers and dads sit at the bed of a child, who was gunned down by a de-ranged maniac. Yes, their situations would try the hope and faith of most of us. Many Americans live on the edge of despair; and some give up – daily; on average 121 adults and teens will take their lives daily.

Is there hope for mankind living in such a trouble world, a world that seems to be filled with angry, hateful people? For many, their hope is found in a person, the Lord Jesus Christ. He is their HOPE (1 Timothy 1:1). Long ago, he experienced the hate, anger, and rejection by leading authorities; they even executed Him by nailing Him to a tree. Yet, on that cross, He offered forgiveness for His executioners; and Scripture teaches us that He personally bore the weight of man's sin (1 Peter 2:24). Yes, the Lord Jesus is our hope; and He gives hope to anyone who truly trusts in Him.

May our Lord's words encourage the bereaved with these words: "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me will live; and whoever lives and believes in Me will never die!" (John 11:25, 26)

## 4. Planning and Implementing Care

You and/or your representative have the right to be fully informed of your medical condition in a language you can understand, and to participate in your person-centered care planning and treatment, including the type of caregiver who provides services to you. You also have the right to refuse and/or discontinue medications and treatments (but this could be harmful to your health), and to formulate an advanced directive.

## 5. Choice of Attending Physician

You have the right to choose and see your own doctor.

## 6. Respect, Dignity and Self-Determination

You have the right to be treated with respect and dignity.

You have the right to retain and use personal possessions.

You have the right to the reasonable accommodation of your needs so long as it doesn't endanger the health or safety of you or other residents.

You have the right to choose your roommate when practicable.

You have the right to choose activities and schedules (including sleeping and waking times).

You have the right to participate in community activities both inside and outside of Pleasant View Home.

You have the right to spend private time with visitors. Pleasant View Home must permit your family, your representative(s), your physician, a representative of the state, and your Kansas Long Term Care Ombudsman to visit you at any time. You don't have to see any visitor you don't want to see. Additionally, Pleasant View Home must provide you with reasonable access to any person who gives you help with your health, social or legal needs.

You have the right to manage your own money or choose someone you trust to do this for you. If you ask Pleasant View Home to manage your personal funds, you must sign a written statement that allows Pleasant View Home to do this for you. Pleasant View Home must allow you access to your bank accounts, cash, and other financial records. Pleasant View Home must place your money over \$100 (\$50 for those receiving Medicaid) in an account that provides interest, and they must give you quarterly statements. Pleasant View Home must protect your funds from any loss by buying a bond or providing other similar protections.






