#### *From the Administrator*

The following headlines caught my eye recently: Consuming high amounts of caffeine appears to protect women from developing dementia or cognitive impairment, according to the results of a new study published in *The Journals of Gerontology, Series A: Biological Sciences and Medical Sciences*. Any study that promotes drinking copious amounts of coffee, is my kind of research.

On a more serious note, they say one of the most feared conditions by Americans today, is no longer the dreaded heart attack or even the more dreaded cancer. These fears have been replaced by the fear of memory loss related conditions.

On this same subject, the new CMS regulations for nursing homes insist that caregivers consider non-pharmacological approaches to caring for elders with dementia. With that, our staff is being resourceful with providing comfort and pleasure with our Music & Memory program, aromatherapy, enhanced resident centered activities and other approaches.

A new intervention that we are exploring, that has revealed some exciting outcomes, is the use of companion pets. These are small dog and cat replicas with light, sound and touch sensors that mimic a real animal, bringing joy and comfort to elders. We have seen the joy on the faces of our residents as they interact with a companion pet. As a side note: if you are looking for a unique gift for an elder loved one, this could be a great idea. – Check them out on-line, it's the Joy for All Companion Pets, by searching, "Hasbro Companion Pet", and choosing "cat or dog". Hope to see you all at Gift Day on Nov. 10!

Exercise is Key to Healthy Aging ~Dr. Richard J. Hodes

What You Need to Know About Exercise  
What is the best kind of exercise?

Most people tend to focus on one activity or type of exercise. The goal, however, is to be creative and do all four types of exercise—endurance, strength, balance and flexibility.

Endurance, or aerobic, activities increase your breathing and heart rate. They help keep you healthy, improve fitness and carry out everyday tasks.

To strengthen your muscles, you need to lift or push weight. Even very small changes can make a real difference. Stronger muscles can make it easier to get up from a chair, carry groceries, open jars, work in the garden and even play with your grandchildren.

Each year, more than 2 million older Americans go to the emergency room because of fall-related injuries. Balance exercises are one way to help prevent falling.

Flexibility, or stretching exercises give you more freedom of movement for everyday activities.

How can I find time to exercise?

There are a number of ways to fit exercise and physical activity into your schedule. For example, exercise first thing in the morning or combine physical activity with a task that's already part of your day, such as walking the dog.

Do I need any equipment?

For many activities, you don't need any equipment or special clothing. All you need for brisk walking, for example, is a pair of comfortable, non-skid shoes. For strength training, you can make your own weights from unbreakable household items.

Is it better to exercise in a group or alone?

The key is to do what you truly enjoy, which could be with others or on your own. A team activity like basketball or a group exercise class might be appealing. Or, on their own, some people find going to a gym regularly or working with a trainer helps them stay motivated.

What should people who are overweight or obese do?

Try walking, water exercises, dancing or weight lifting, varying your activities to include endurance, strength, balance and flexibility. Anything that gets you moving—even for only a few minutes a day in the beginning—is a healthy start. Feel good about what you can do, and pat yourself on the back for trying. It should get easier.

## Bill of Rights of Pleasant View Home

These rights were signed by the residents of Pleasant View Home or the residents DPOA. If at anytime the resident or DPOA need to discuss them, we ask that you speak to the Social Service Designee here at Pleasant View Home. This year we have 33 Bill of Rights to review: These are read and discussed at the resident council meeting the first of each month.

14. The Resident has a right to voice grievances with respect to treatment or care that fails to be furnished without discrimination or reprisal for voicing grievances.
15. The Resident has a right to prompt efforts by the Facility to resolve grievances including those with respect to the behavior of other Residents.
16. The Resident has a right to examine the results of the most recent survey of the Facility conducted by Federal and State surveyors and any plan of correction in effect with respect to the Facility.

# Chaplains Corner

When British evangelist John Wesley (1703-1791) was returning home from a service one night, he was robbed. The thief, however, found his victim to have only a little money and some Christian literature. As the bandit was leaving, Wesley called out, "Stop! I have something more to give you." The surprised robber paused. "My friend," said Wesley, "you may live to regret this sort of life. If you ever do, here's something to remember: "The blood of Jesus Christ cleanses us from all sin (I John 1:7)!" The thief hurried away; and Wesley prayed that his words might bear fruit.

Years later, Wesley was greeting people after a Sunday service when he was approached by a stranger. What a surprise to learn that this visitor, now a believer in Christ as a successful businessman, was the one who had robbed him years before! "I owe it all to you," said the transformed man. "Oh no, my friend," Wesley exclaimed, "not to me, but to the precious blood of Christ that cleanses us from all sin!"

This marvelous story from the life of godly John Wesley illustrates the power of triumphant Christian living, accepting, appropriating, and living the very words of Scripture. I am confident that he found no difficulty in appropriating another Scripture in his life: "**In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you**" (I Thessalonians 5:18). I am confident that after this conversation with this businessman at church, he was thankful to the Lord for his response to that man when they first met.
