As some nursing homes are emerging from the four-month lockdown due to the COVID-19 pandemic, one of the important questions for residents and families is: "When will I be able to visit my loved one in the nursing home?"

Visits are still possible at Pleasant View Home, but they are different than before the pandemic. There are many factors that play into decisions about visitation. Those include, community spread, availability of testing, adequate supplies of personal protective equipment and staffing.

At Pleasant View we are excited to offer several popular options of visitation at this time.

1. Outdoor visits can be arranged where the resident and family have 6 foot distancing with masks. Children can also be included in the outdoor visits as long as they can abide by the social distancing and mask requirements.
2. Window visits have been a popular option from the beginning. With a closed window between the resident and the family a visit can be enhanced with the use of our window intercom which gently amplifies the voice from each side of the window making it easy to hear.
3. Never mind the weather, consider an indoor visit at our visitation booth area. A custom built plexiglass screen offers full view of residents and guests while in the comfort of our building.

We ask that all visitors make appointments in advance with our Social Worker, Kelsey Hodges, so our areas will be sanitized, and the resident is ready for the visit. Kelsey would be glad to answer any questions about the visit that you may have. Visitors will check in at the West View lobby for screening prior to the visit.

As time marches on, we will look forward to less restrictive visitation opportunities, including visits in the resident rooms, but we will need to be patient for now, and as always, the health and safety of our residents is our goal.
